This week everyone has been dressing as their favourite characters from stories. They changed the idea a bit and put the names in a hat and guessed whose favourite character they had chosen.

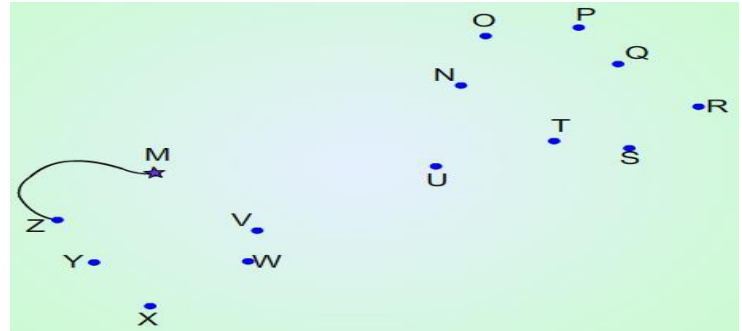

How Never-ending Stories Began

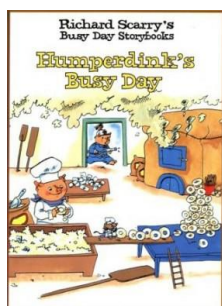
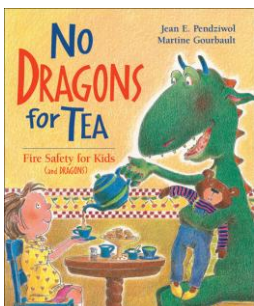
