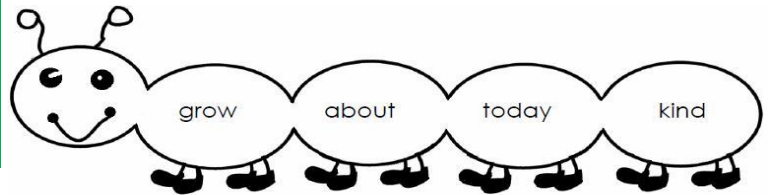
It never stops being strange that in the Northern hemisphere the toys are getting ready to hibernate as the days are getting shorter and the nights longer.

Timid Timothy's Book Quiz

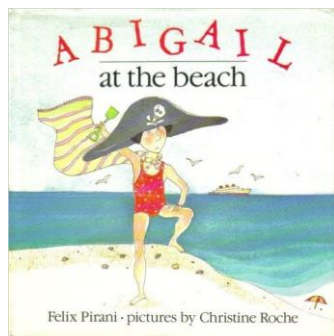
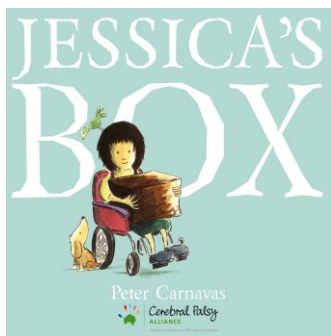
Eager Emily is helping Timid Timothy remember all the parts of a book by making this poster for him?
